CRITERIA FOR AWARDING FUNDING FOR

capital projects

The Public Place Recycling Scheme (PPRS) is wholly funded on a voluntary basis by the commercial sector working with councils and community groups as partners. The PPRS promotes the Love NZ brand.

As part of this scheme we will provide funding on a contestable basis to support community investment in recycling and waste infrastructure and to help seed fund commercial investment in recycling and waste facilities at high traffic public locations. The overarching objective is to support initiatives which will increase and promote public place recycling and reduce litter.

Allocations will be based on whether the project meets one or more of the following criteria:

- Tourist locations with high density visitor populations
- Communities which do not currently have recycling facilities
- Keeping our waterways clean and green
- High traffic areas such as transport hubs, educational institutions, shopping centres, DHB's, sports and entertainment venues, tourist attractions
- Delivering programme which will promote Love NZ to the public through branding on recycling bins, promotional materials, communications etc.

The size of grants to be awarded will be determined according to the merits of each application however as guidance:

- Our objective is to increase the number of recycling bins available nationwide with the best value infrastructure to meet the requirements of the location
- There are a wide variety of recycling and waste bins available at vastly

different price ranges. The PPRS will assist with funding for dual recycling/waste bin units or multiple units which collect glass, mixed recycling, paper, waste separately

- We will where possible look for standardisation of PPR bins in terms of style, colours and messaging to increase consumer awareness
- Financial support will be based on the PPRS management's understanding of the design, performance and cost of bins
- It is expected that applicants will contribute to the purchase costs although exceptions may be made at the discretion of the scheme management
- The cost of servicing the bins must be covered by the applicant for a minimum of 3 years
- Recycling bins will carry the Love NZ logo and it is expected that in good faith recipients will extend the use of the Love NZ brand to recycling bins which they purchase themselves
- The recipient will provide recycling and waste data (in kilograms unless otherwise agreed) to the scheme management on a bi-monthly basis.
